Exam Proctoring Policy

The Berkley Public Library offers proctoring services to members of the public. The charge for proctoring an exam is \$10 for Berkley residents and \$20 for non-residents (as stated in the City's fee schedule). The following outlines the library's proctoring service.

- 1. Proctoring is available by appointment only and must generally be scheduled at least one week prior to the desired exam date.
- 2. Any librarian can proctor an exam. Speak to a librarian to schedule a proctoring session. Additional staff may need to be consulted prior to finalizing a proctoring appointment.
- 3. Proctoring is offered during the library's regular business hours.
- 4. The library cannot guarantee that a student will be observed at all times during an exam.
- 5. The proctor fee is due at the time the test is administered. Proctor fees will be entered in the cash register under "Fines & Fees."
- 6. The student is responsible for any fees associated with the return or submission of the completed exam.
- 7. The library reserves the right to refuse proctoring if the requirements exceed staff or facility capabilities.
