Study Room Policy

The purpose of the library's study rooms is to provide space for study and/or collaborative work.

- 1. Study rooms are available free of charge and are open during library hours.
- 2. Study rooms can accommodate one (1) to four (4) people.
- 3. Study rooms are available on a first come, first served basis. Study rooms may not be reserved ahead of time.
- 4. Study rooms can be used in one-hour increments per person or group. If no one is waiting for a room, additional time may be granted. Check in at the reference desk to access a study room.
- 5. Noise volume within study rooms must be kept to a low level.
- 6. Study rooms must be vacated fifteen (15) minutes before the library's closing.
- 7. Study rooms must be left in the condition they were found.
- 8. Those using the study rooms must adhere to the library's Code of Conduct.
