




### A Community Gathering Space

"Nice location. This makes it feel like a real community."



Q3 Did you attend a specific event at Dorothea Pocket Park?




"It's a nice place to sit and relax, even if there isn't an event going on."




"The yoga class was great -- good area to have little events!"
