# **AARP Tax-Aide Important Information**

By Appointment Only: To make an appointment, please call the Berkley Community Center beginning January 5, 2026 at 248-658-3470.

Appointments will take place at 2400 Robina Avenue, Berkley MI 48072 on these dates:

- Thursdays starting February 5, 2026 through April 9, 2026
- Mondays starting February 9, 2026 through April 13, 2026 (NEW FOR THIS YEAR!)
- CLOSED for Taxes on these dates: February 16, 2026, February 19, 2026 and April 2, 2026.

**IMPORTANT:** You need to come to the Berkley Community Center (2400 Robina Avenue) to pick up your tax packet before your appointment date. This packet provides information on what to bring to your appointment and includes paperwork that has to be filled out ahead of time.

- See the envelope instructions AND the Intake/Interview Form included in the packet.
- You MUST complete the Intake/Interview Form before your appointment.

### What to bring to your appointment:

- Social Security cards and/or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number notices/cards for every individual on your return (may be a picture on your phone).
- Government-issued photo ID for you (and your spouse if Married Filing Jointly).
- Your tax return from last year as well as any previous years if you are working on multiple years. If you have multiple years, **you must reserve a separate appointment for each year**.
- Your completed Tax Aide Intake Packet including the Intake/Interview Form.
- Proof of checking or savings routing and account numbers (such as a voided check) if you want to
  direct-deposit any refund(s) or direct-debit any amounts due. Note: Direct Deposit is the safest,
  quickest way to receive your refund. Payments will take an additional 6 weeks or longer for refunds
  sent by mail due to new IRS policies.
- All tax correspondence received from the IRS, the State of Michigan and your local city.
- Identity Protection Pin (IP Pin) if anyone on your return has been issued one by the IRS. If you have, you should receive a new 6-digit PIN each year from the IRS.

### You will also want to bring:

- All your normal income tax documents -- W-2 forms, all 1099 forms (e.g. SSA-1099 Social Security, 1099-NEC, 1099-G Unemployment Compensation or state/local income tax refunds, 1099-INT Interest, 1099-DIV Dividends, 1099-R forms for pensions, annuities or IRA distributions, 1099-MISC, 1099-K), brokerage statements, gambling winnings, etc.
- Affordable Health Care Statement Form 1095-A (Obamacare).
- Both Summer and Winter Property Tax statements showing taxes assessed for 2025.
- Records of any estimated tax payments.
- Most people use the standard deduction and do not itemize. If you think you may be able to itemize, bring documentation to support your expenses. Items that may qualify for itemized deduction include medical expenses, gifts to charity, state/local taxes, mortgage interest. Note: in order to itemize your deductions, they must total more than the standard deduction for your filing status.
- Check your last tax return and make certain that you either have a tax form from every organization from which you received one in the prior year, or know why you do not have that form this year.
- This list may not include everything you need and you may not have all of these items.



Welcome to the Berkley Transportation Service. We look forward to assisting you with all of your transportation needs. Reservations can be made for trips to the doctor, salons, shopping centers and more.

### **General Information**

- Senior Van Transportation is available for Berkley residents who are over the age of 50, retired or semi-retired. All vehicles are equipped with wheelchair lifts for anyone in need.
- A suggested donation of \$3 for one-way trips or \$5 for round trips is recommended.
- Transportation is available Monday through Friday between 8:30am and 4:00pm unless otherwise stated.

### All rides must be completed by 4:00pm

### How to make a van reservation:

- Call Parks and Recreation at 248-658-3470 and ask for transportation.
   Reservations: Monday through Friday between the hours of 9:00am & 12:00pm.
   Requests will not be accepted at any other time.
- Please be prepared to provide your name, address and the address of where you will need to be dropped off.
- Please indicate if you need special assistance like if you are using a walker or are in a wheelchair.
- Reservations need to be made at least two days in advance but can be made months in advance if you have all necessary information.


