

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE:

BACON AVENUE WATER MAIN & ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

The City of Berkley’s contractor (Eminent Excavating) and consulting engineer (Spalding DeDecker) are scheduled to begin work on **Bacon Avenue from 11 Mile Road to 12 Mile Road on June 1st, 2026**. The work consists of placement of new water main and abandoning the existing water main, as well as replacement of storm catch basins and the pavement surface. The water main work will include placement of new water main, testing the main, reconnecting the new main to the existing system, and re-establishing each of your individual water services.

Once the pavement is removed, a gravel base will be provided until paving is complete. In addition, drive approaches and sidewalks will be removed and replaced in the City ROW. Temporary gravel drives will be maintained until the concrete drive approaches are poured.

The project intends to focus on the north end from 12 Mile to Catalpa Drive to complete improvements including base course pavement by the start of school on August 24th. The remainder of the project is to be substantially completed by the end of November 2026.

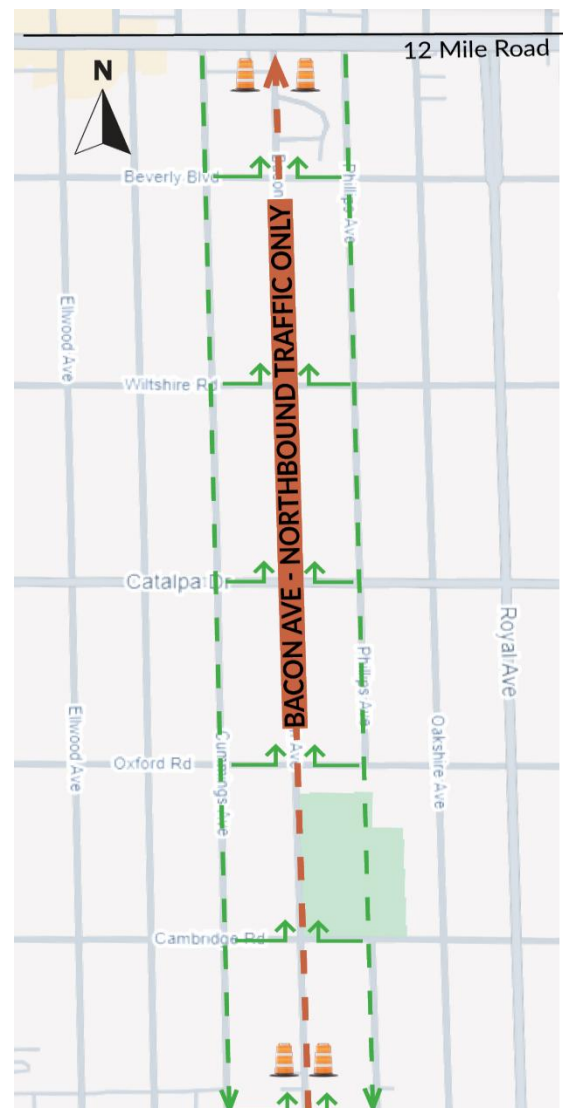
ANTICIPATED JUNE SCHEDULE:

- **Week of June 1st** – Traffic control set up, material and equipment deliveries, and installation of soil erosion measures.
- **Week of June 8th** – Begin demolition and removal of existing pavement starting from the north end at 12 Mile Road and moving south.
- **Week of June 15th** – Installation of water main and storm sewer from 12 Mile Road south.

Note: These dates and durations are subject to change based on weather and other unforeseen factors.

Some other items to note:

- Please label your trash and recycling carts with your address. Continue to bring your trash and recycling carts to the curb as normal and the contractor will ensure it is picked up and the carts are returned. Trash will continue to be picked up on Friday mornings.



One lane of north bound traffic will remain open on Bacon Avenue throughout construction.

- Mail delivery will continue during construction to your mailbox. Parcel delivery will not be affected.
- Residents, especially children, should refrain from entering, walking, or playing in and around the work zone or equipment.
- Residents should expect construction noise and dust during daytime hours. The City's Work Hours Noise Ordinance is 7am to 7pm, Monday through Saturday.
- Residents should locate and mark all irrigation heads adjacent to the roadway as well as turn off the zones associated with these areas prior to work starting, if applicable or necessary.
- Residents should expect piles of material and equipment parked on Bacon Ave.
- **Any residents with special needs** (Example: wheel chair access, medical deliveries and/or appointments, graduations, etc.) **should contact the Construction Engineer or the City of Berkley** (contact information located at the bottom of this notice).

COMMUNICATION:



We understand the impact this work has on our residents. There are delays and unforeseen circumstances in construction, and we want to stay in constant communication with you throughout the duration of the project. Therefore, Spalding DeDecker has set up multiple ways to help residents stay informed. The best way is through our *email program* that provides email alerts concerning this project.
