# 2. Update on Annual Tree Walk

The 2021 Annual Tree walk was a success with 222 trees planted in the fall of 2021. The

Spring tree planting of 30 trees, consisting of 24 varieties, will occur in May of 2022. The Spring planting cost is approximately \$10,000 of which \$4,000 will be from the DTE Grant and the remaining portion will be from the current year City budget. There is a waiting list of approximately 200 residents from the 2021 Tree walk and therefore a Tree walk will not be held in 2022. D. Mihaescu mentioned he will send a tree care communication used in Troy to S.Bard to perhaps integrate with the Berkley Tree care guidelines.

## 3. Spring Clean-up/Project Discussion and Dates

Potential project discussion included cleaning up the bus stop area on Woodward, clean-up and improvements to Friends Park and the Tot lot. The Committee decided to meet with garden tools and recycle bags at the Crispelli's parking lot on Monday, May 2<sup>nd</sup> at 6:30 to clean up the nearby bus stop area. The Committee will discuss and assess other 2022 projects at that time.
