- Provided "Grow Your Own Veggie" kits with journal. Kids encouraged to plant the seeds and track progress.
- Provided cooling relief in July during hot weather.
- Friends sponsored Berkely Street Art Fest; next meeting is Monday, Sept 8.
- DPW cleaned up landscaping around the library.
- Security cameras, including cabling installed.
- Received penal fine payment from the State of Michigan, the amount was generally what had been previously budgeted.
- Working to draft tutoring protocols to ensure Teen Room is fully accessible for middle/high school student groups.
